The castle is on the National Register of Historic Places and is being painstakingly and authentically restored to its original grandeur. The castle was built by in 1903 by George and Sarah Joslyn in the Scottish style. It cost about \$6 million to build in 21st-century dollars. Sarah Joslyn lived in the castle until her death in 1940, and the State of Nebraska assumed ownership two decades later.
